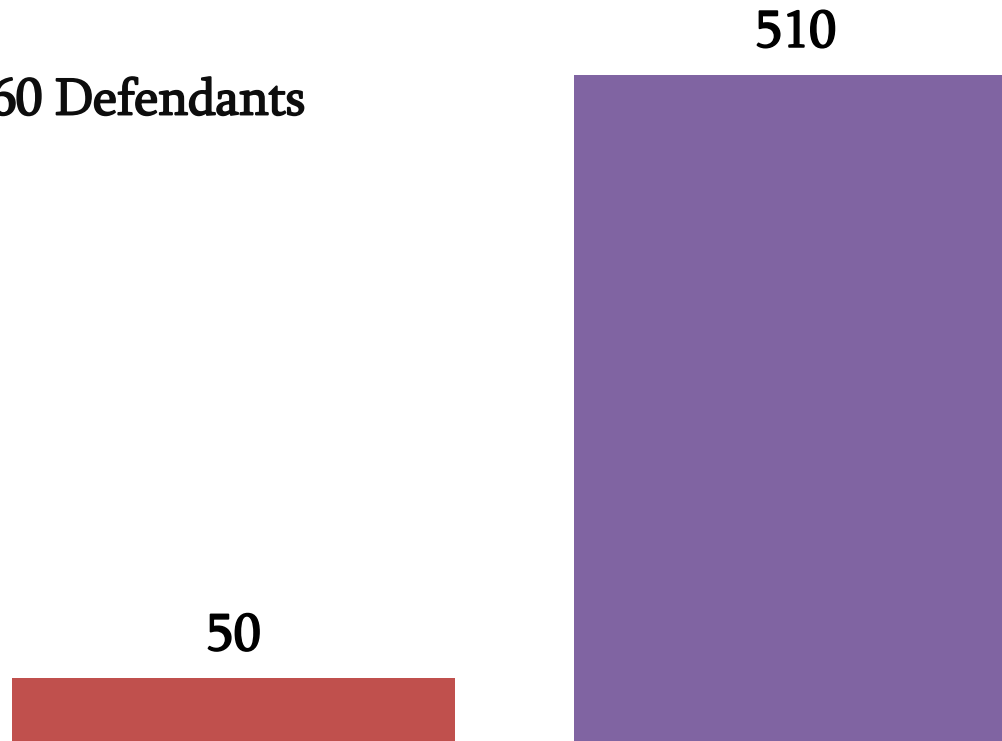

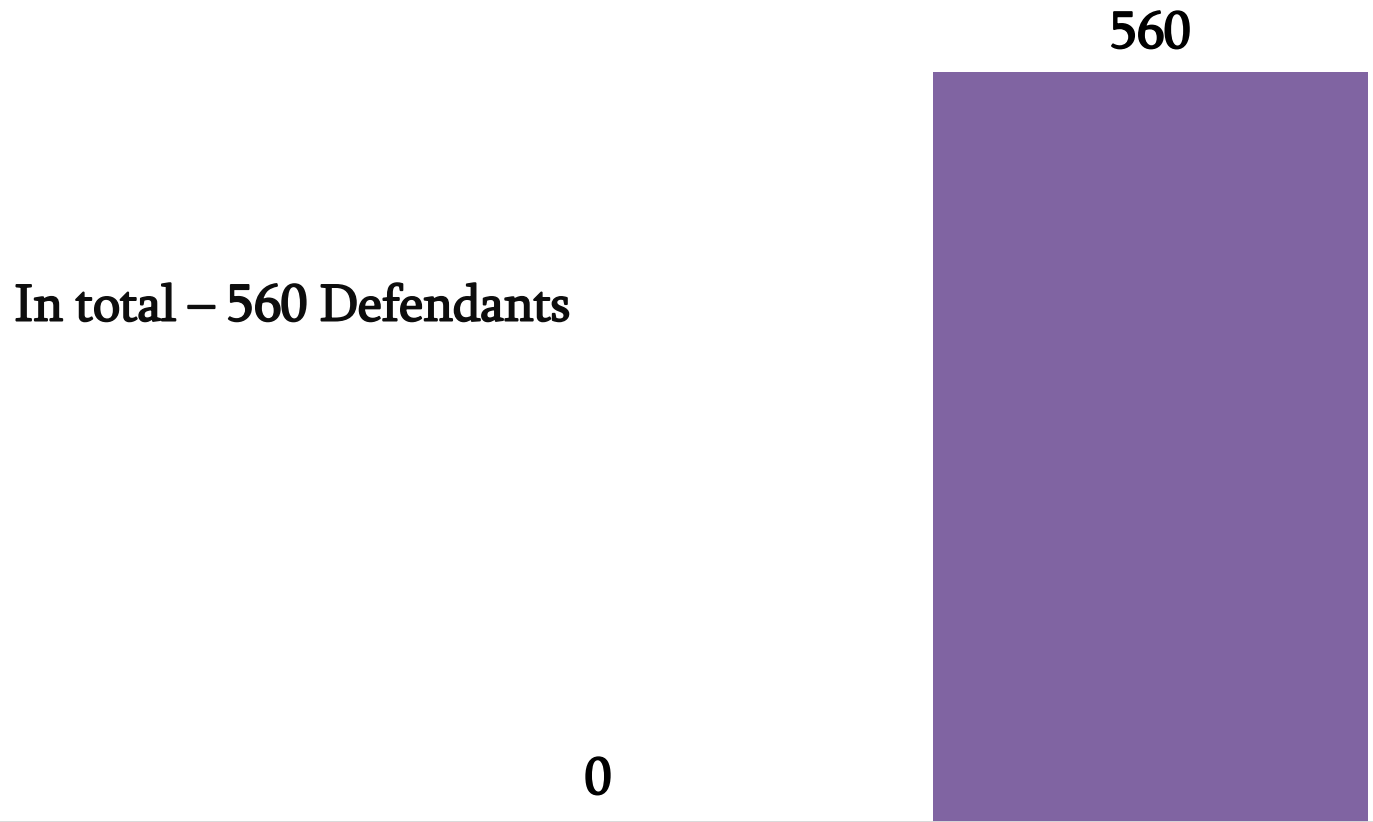

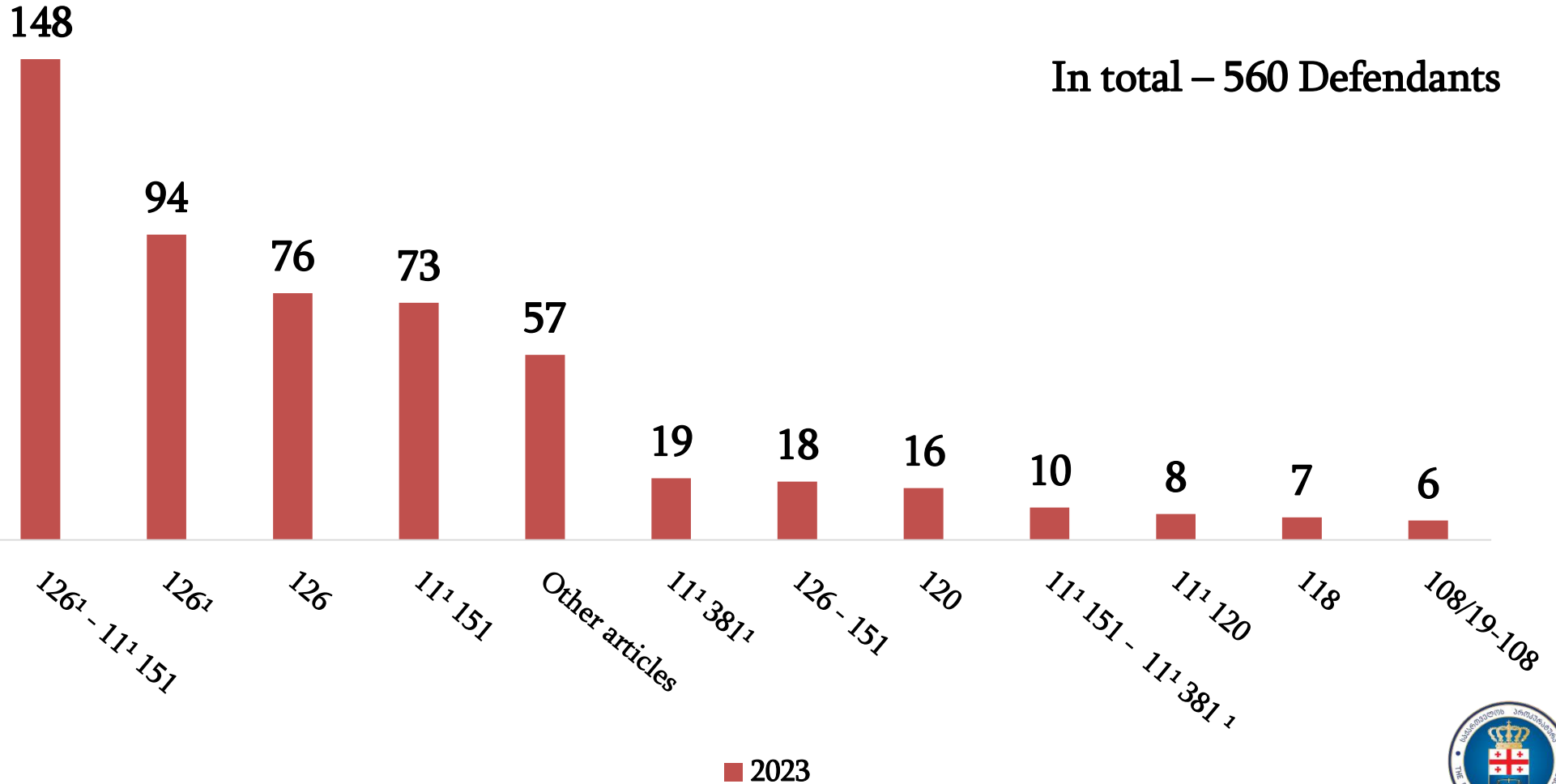

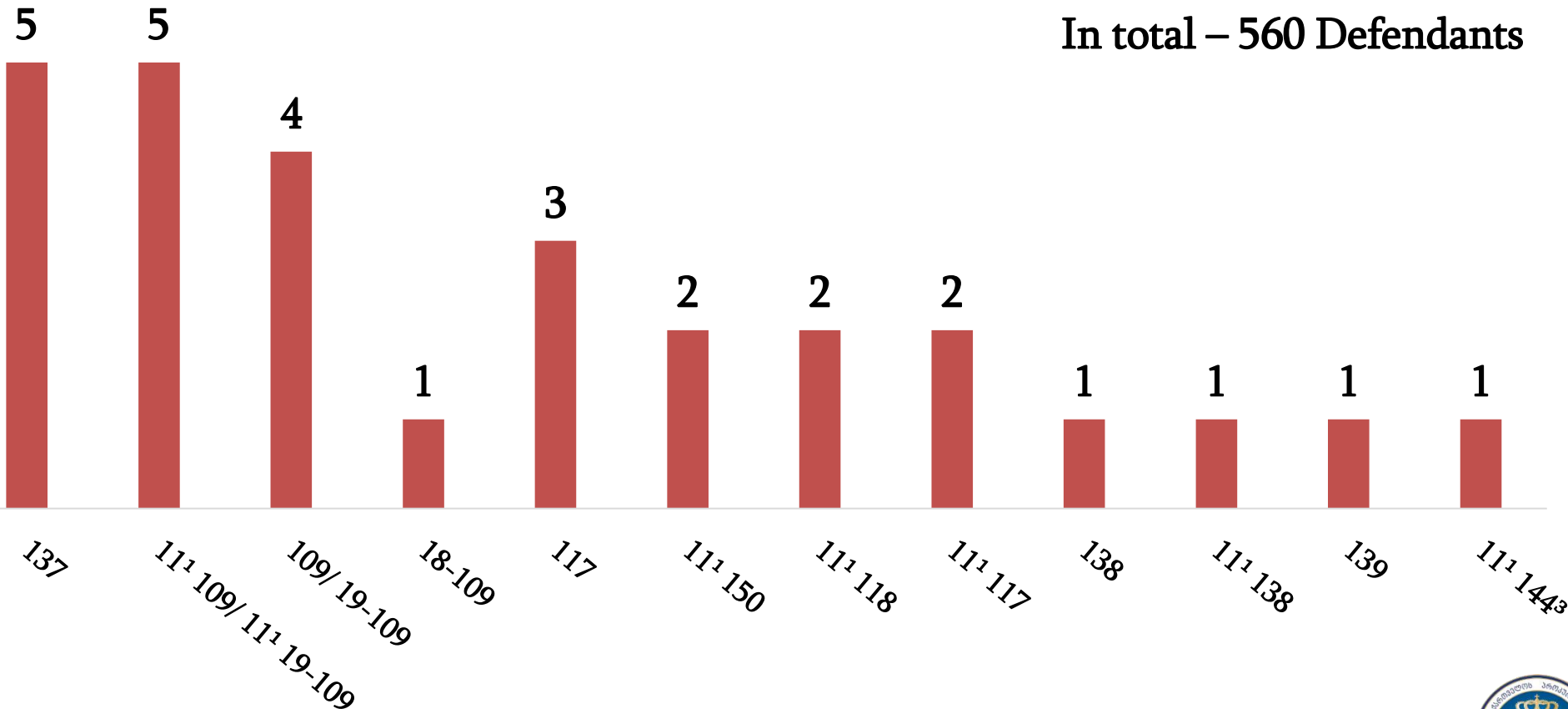

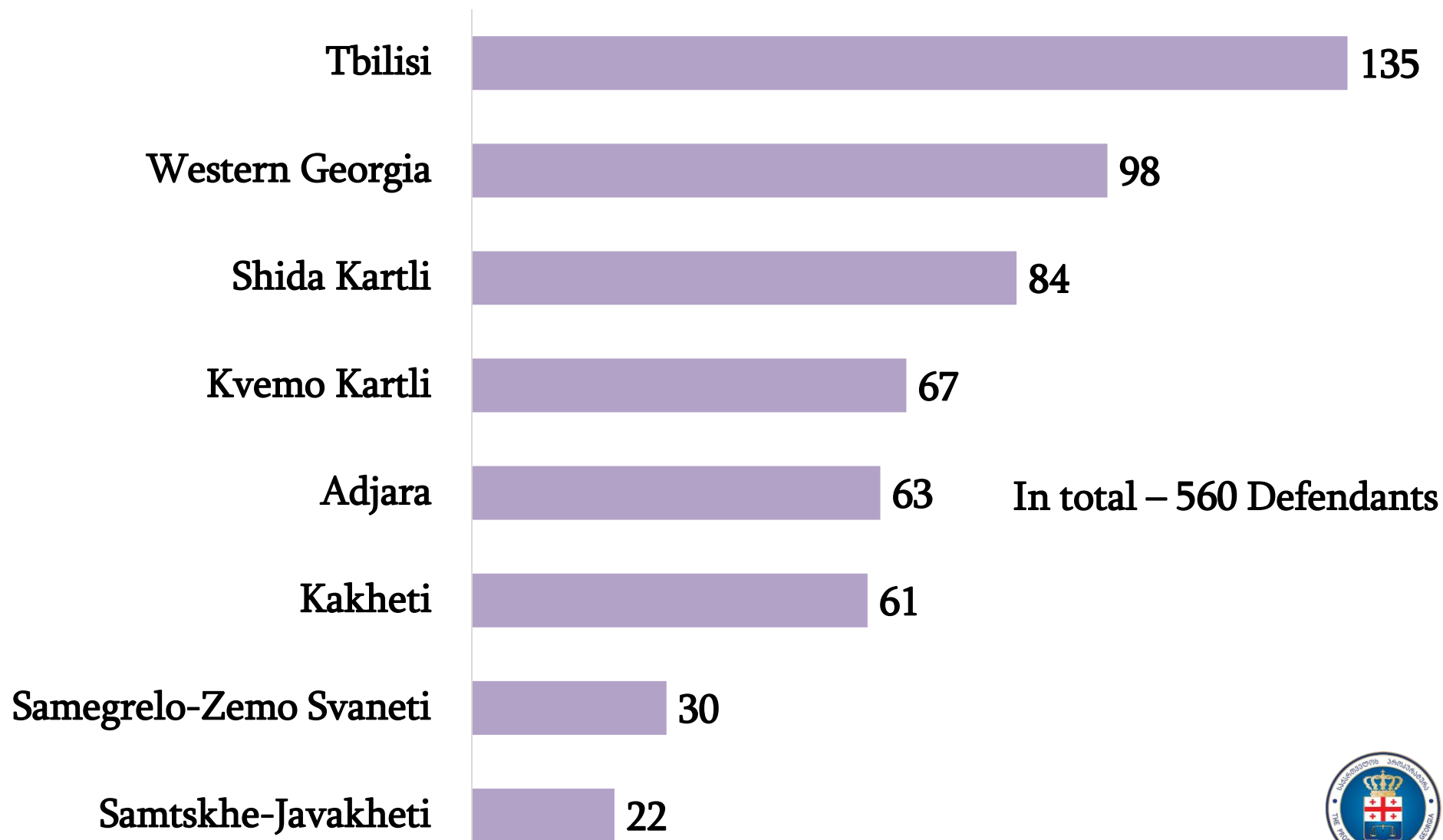

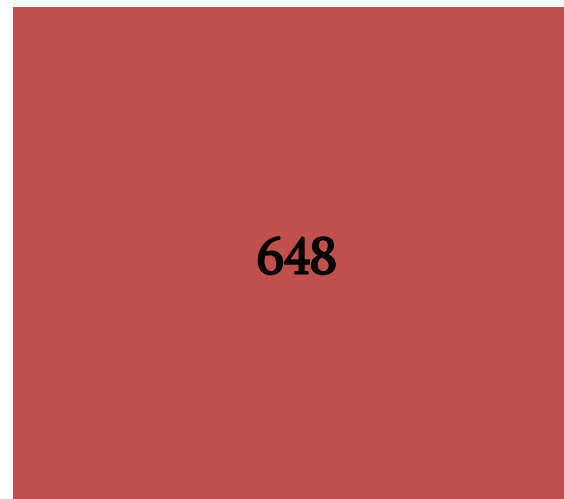

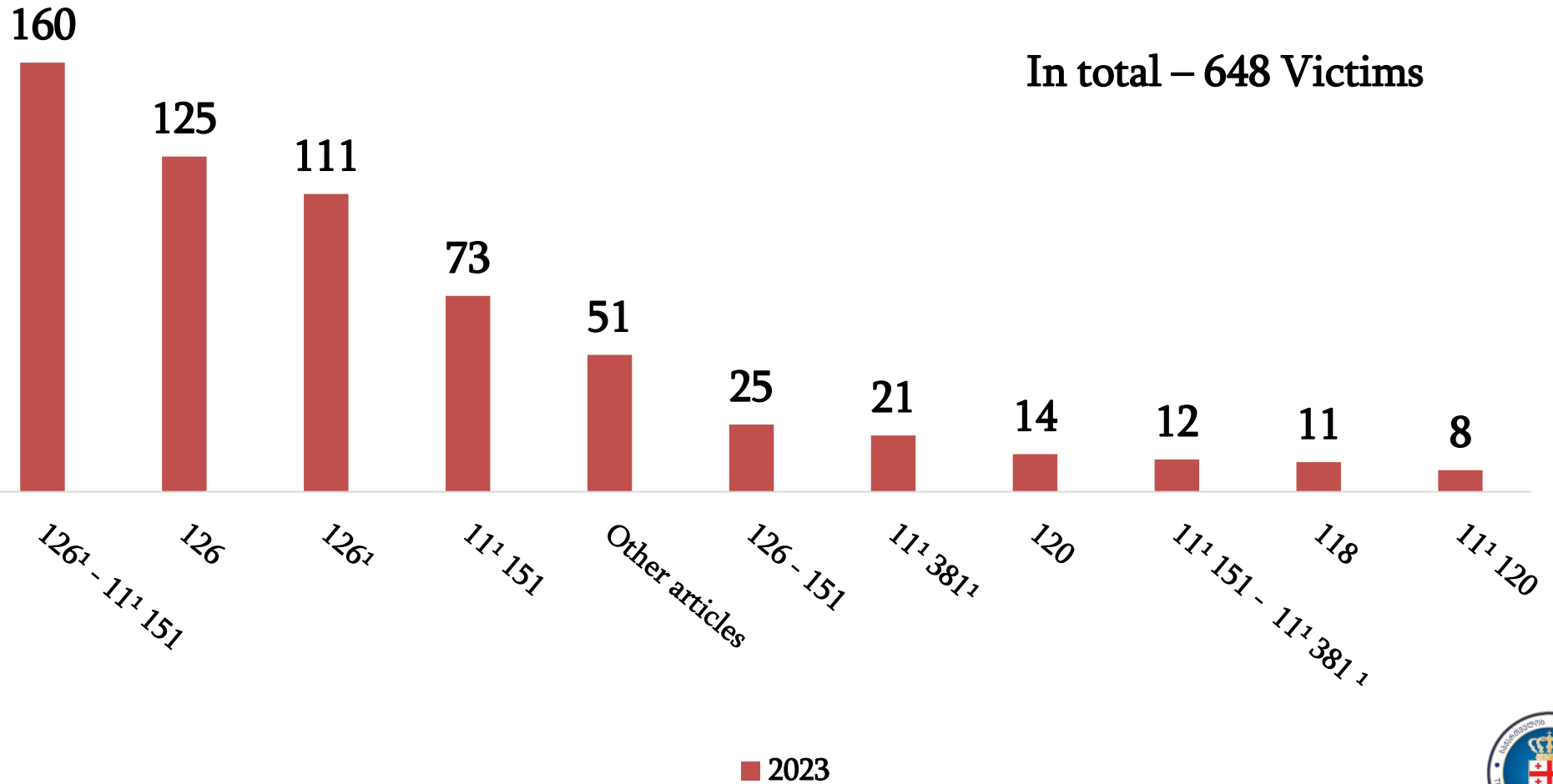

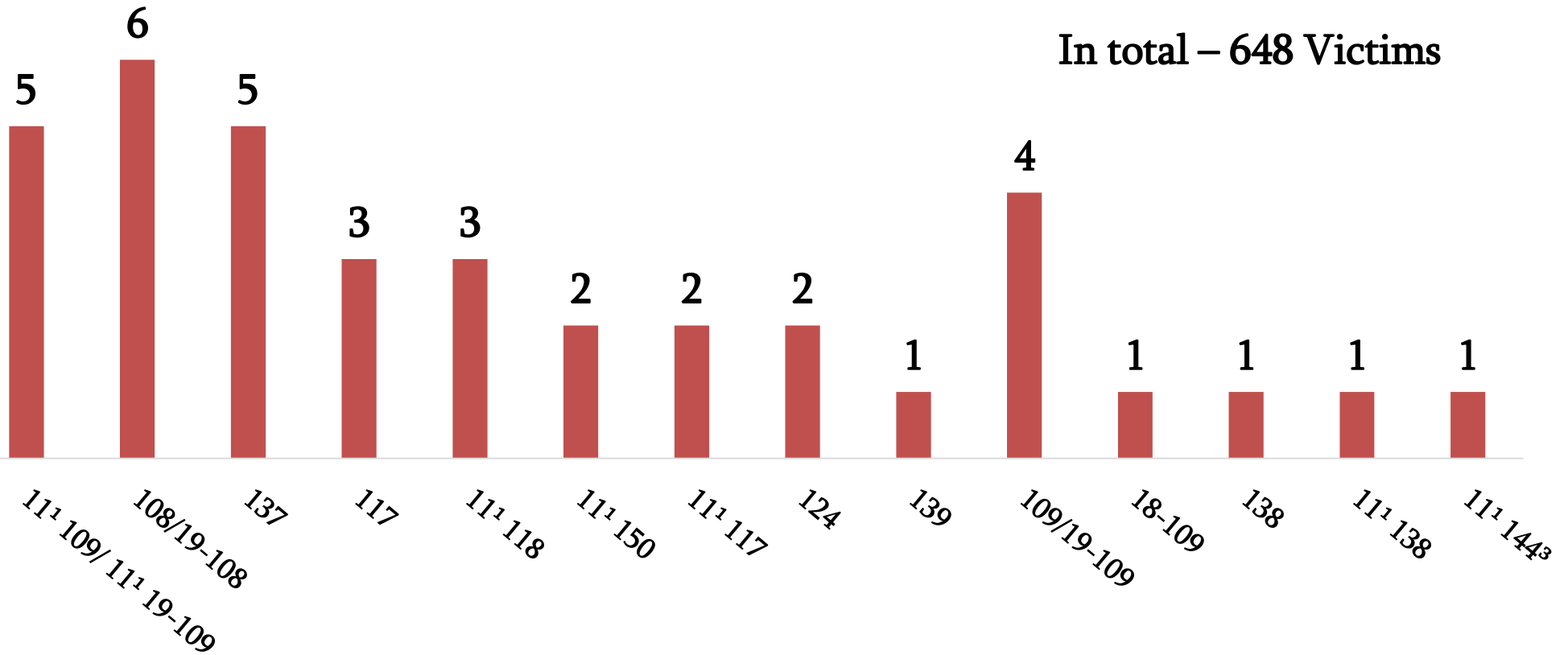

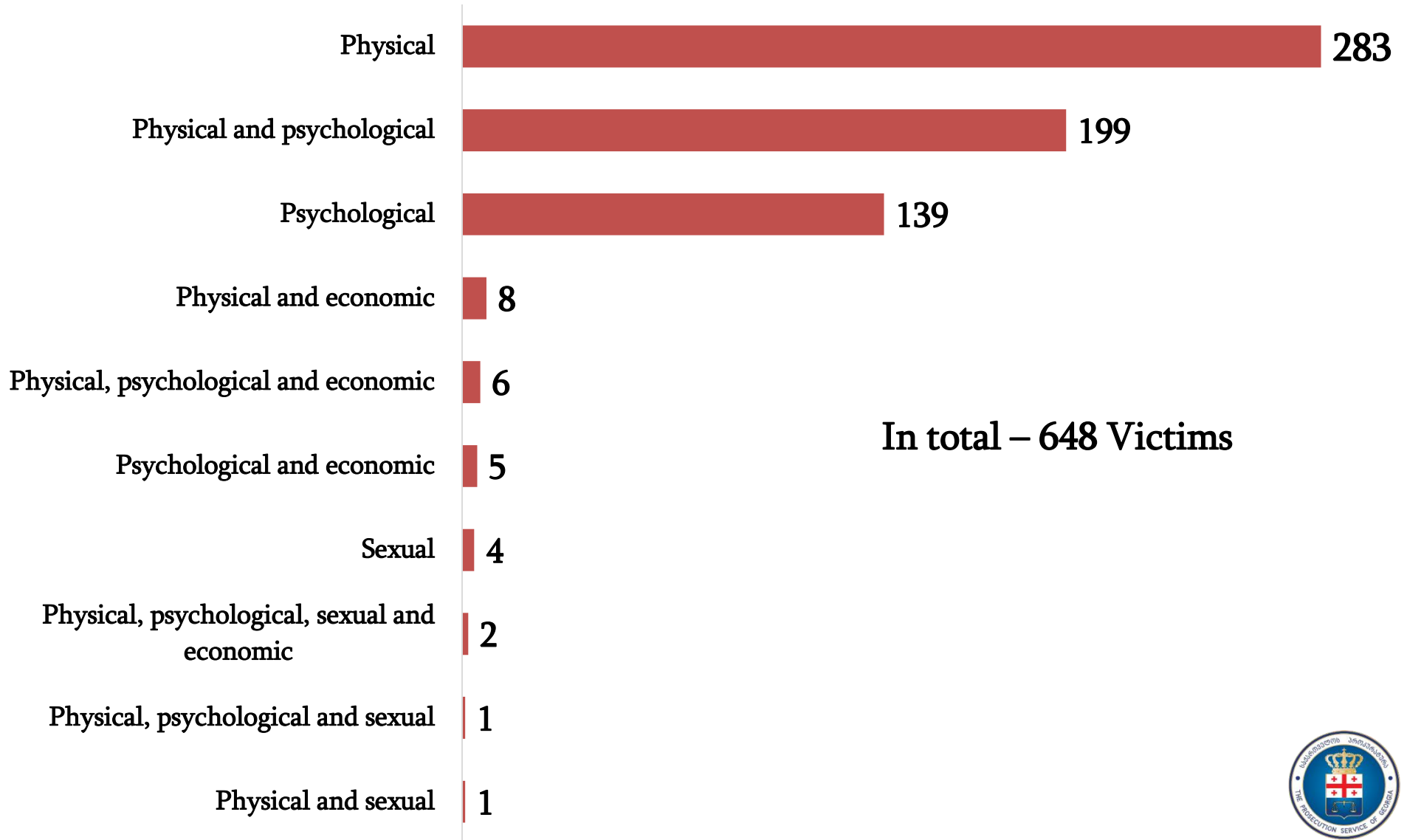

# TERRITORIAL DISTRIBUTION

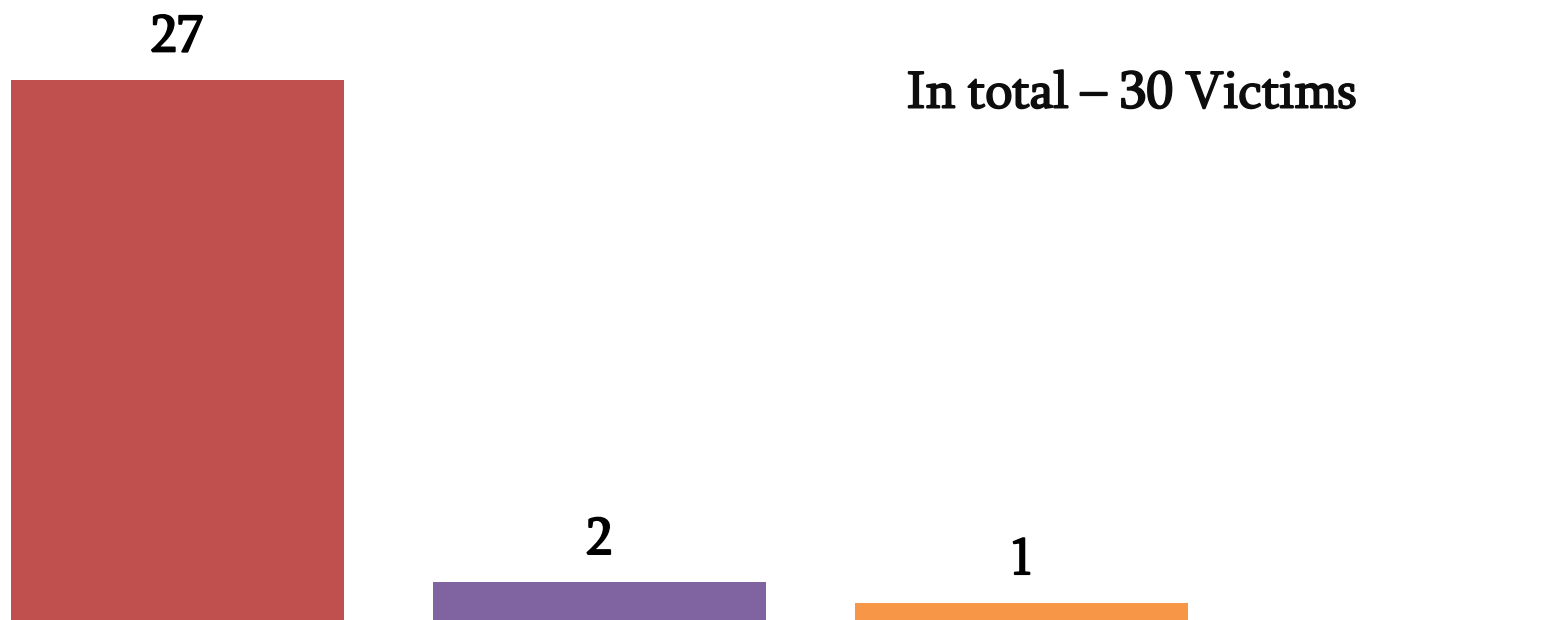

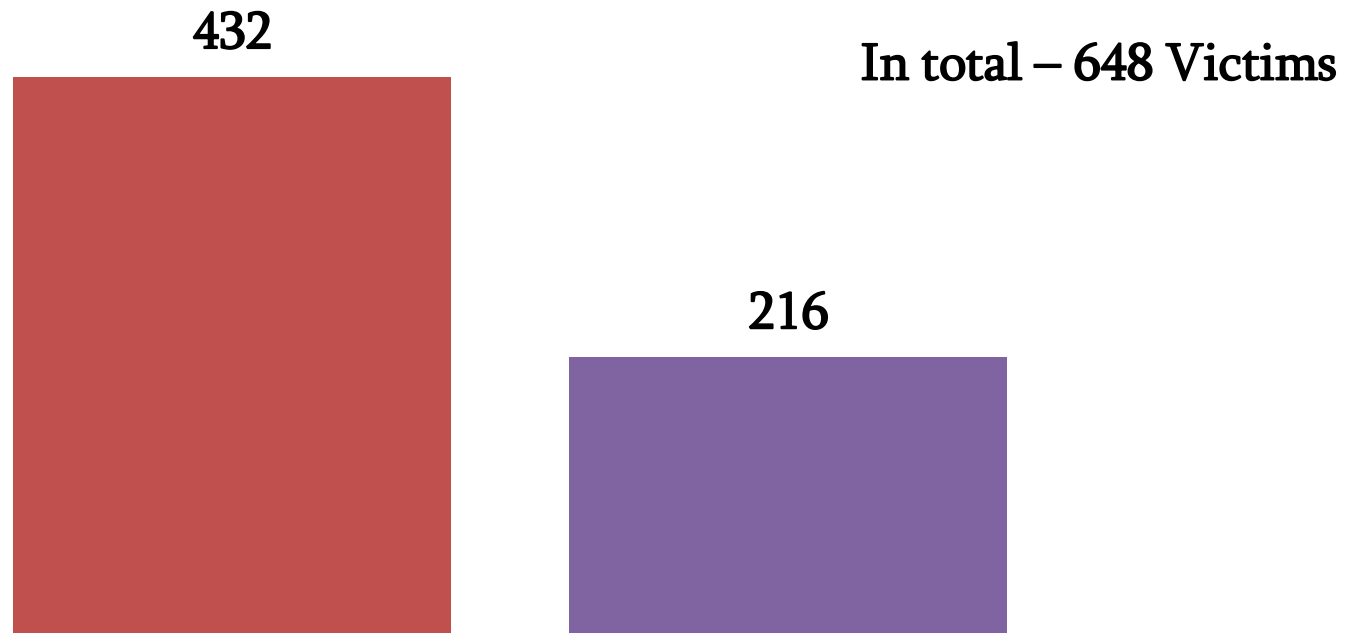

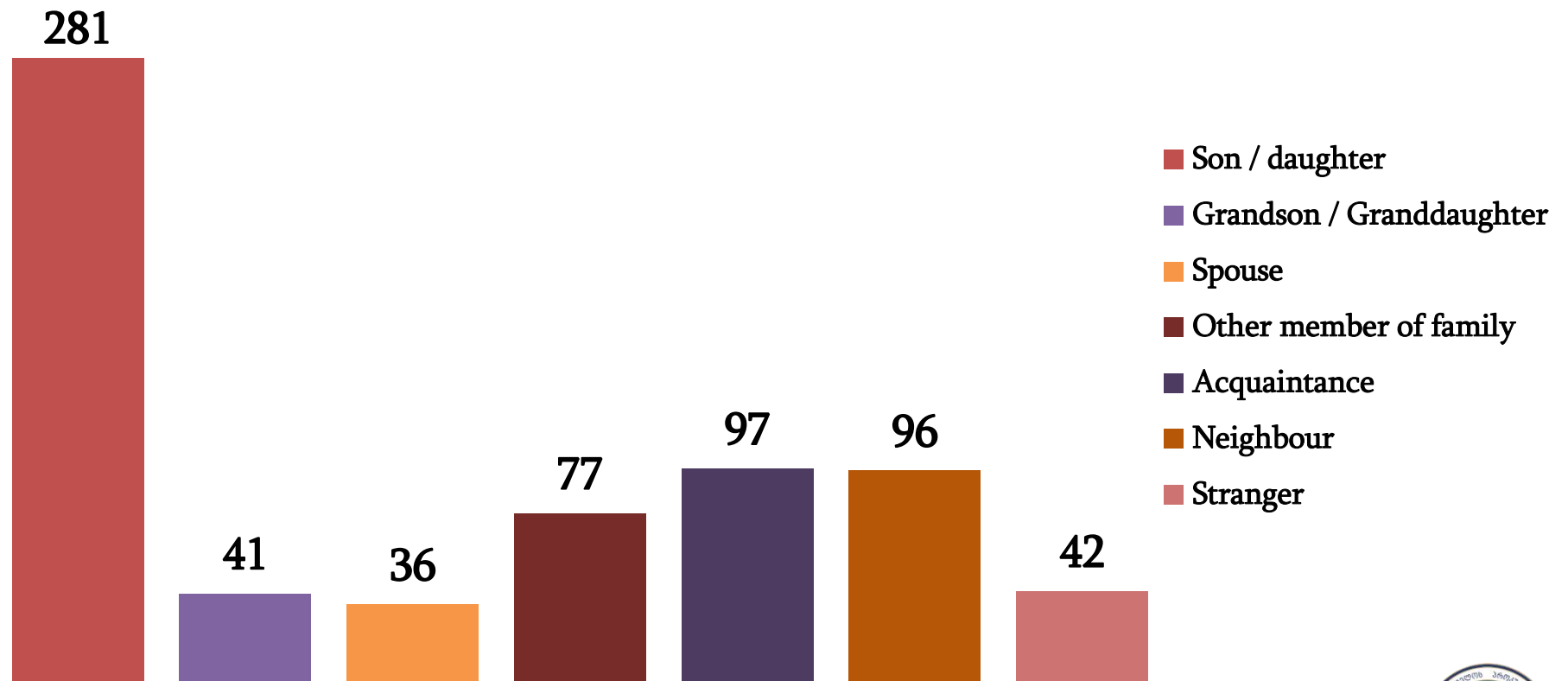

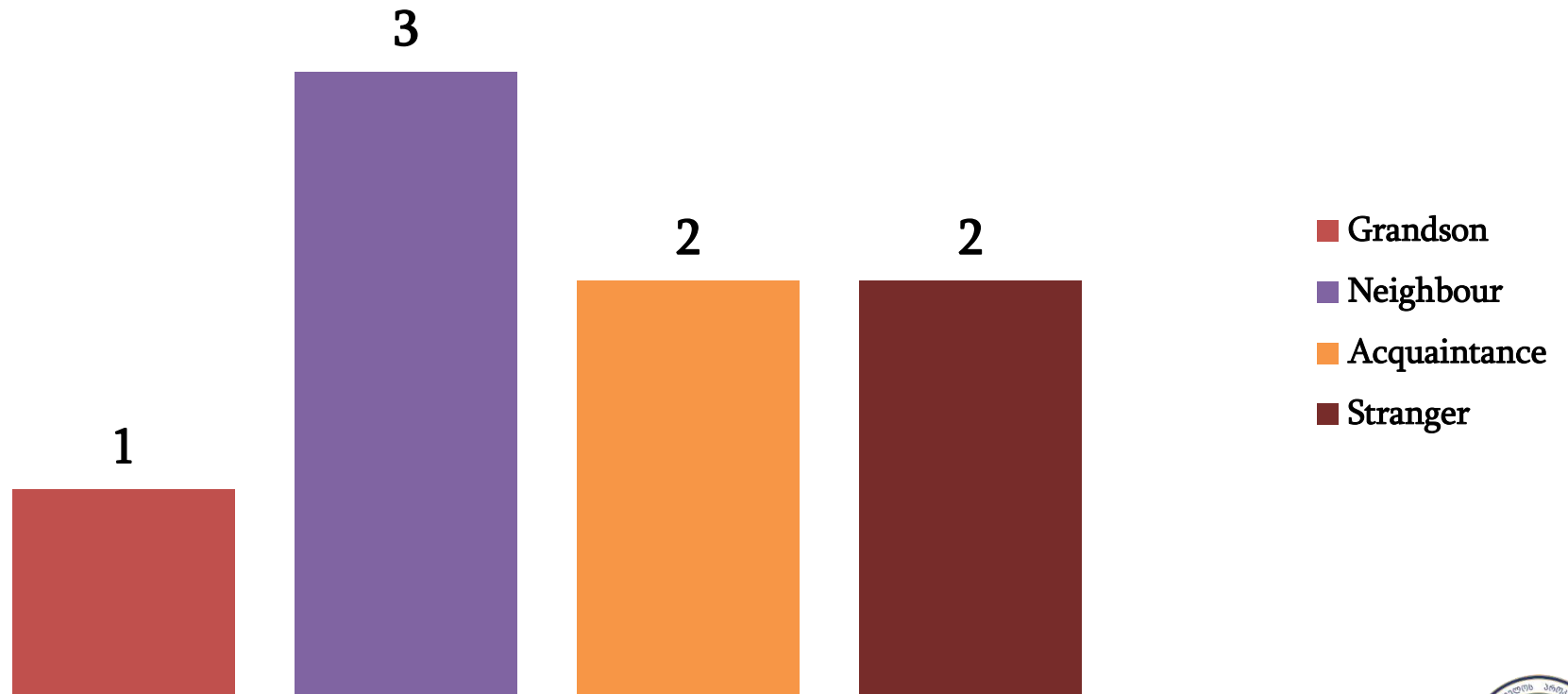
## BETWEEN THE DEFENDANT AND THE VICTIM

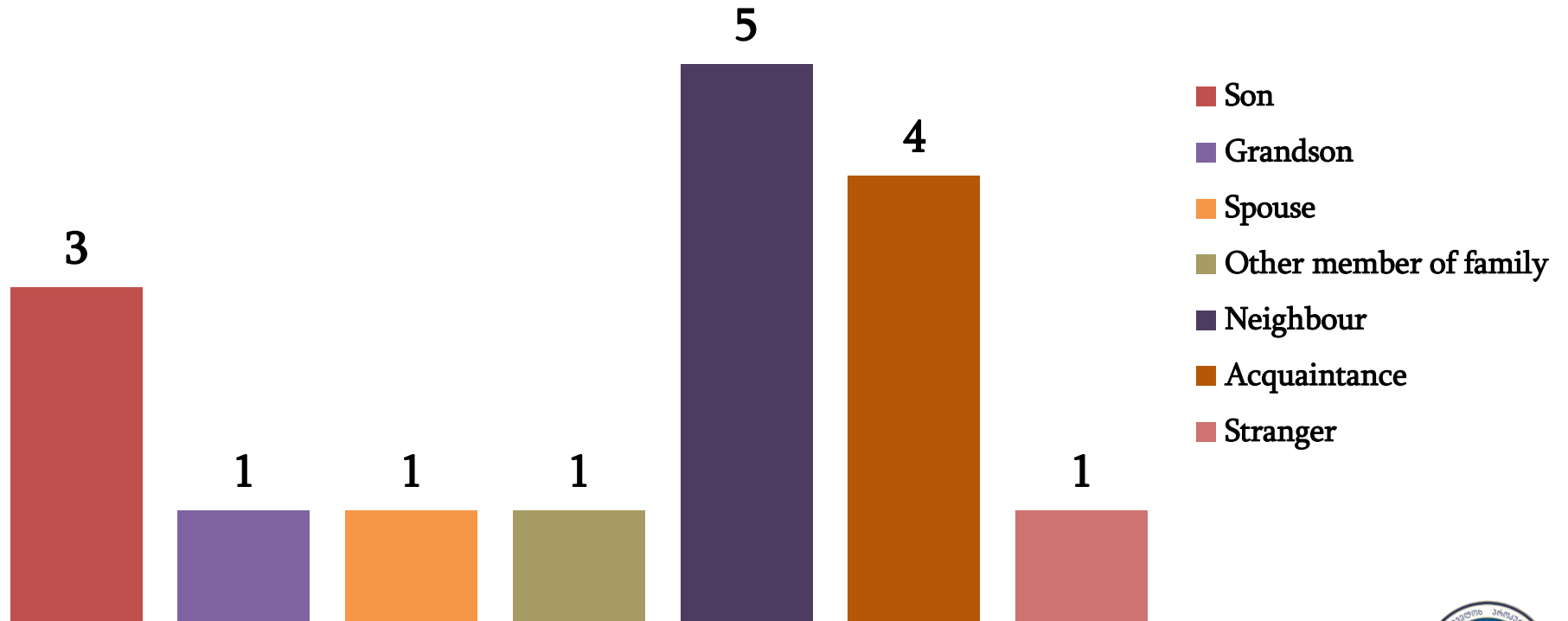
# SOCIAL CONNECTIONS IN SEXUAL VIOLENCE CRIMES

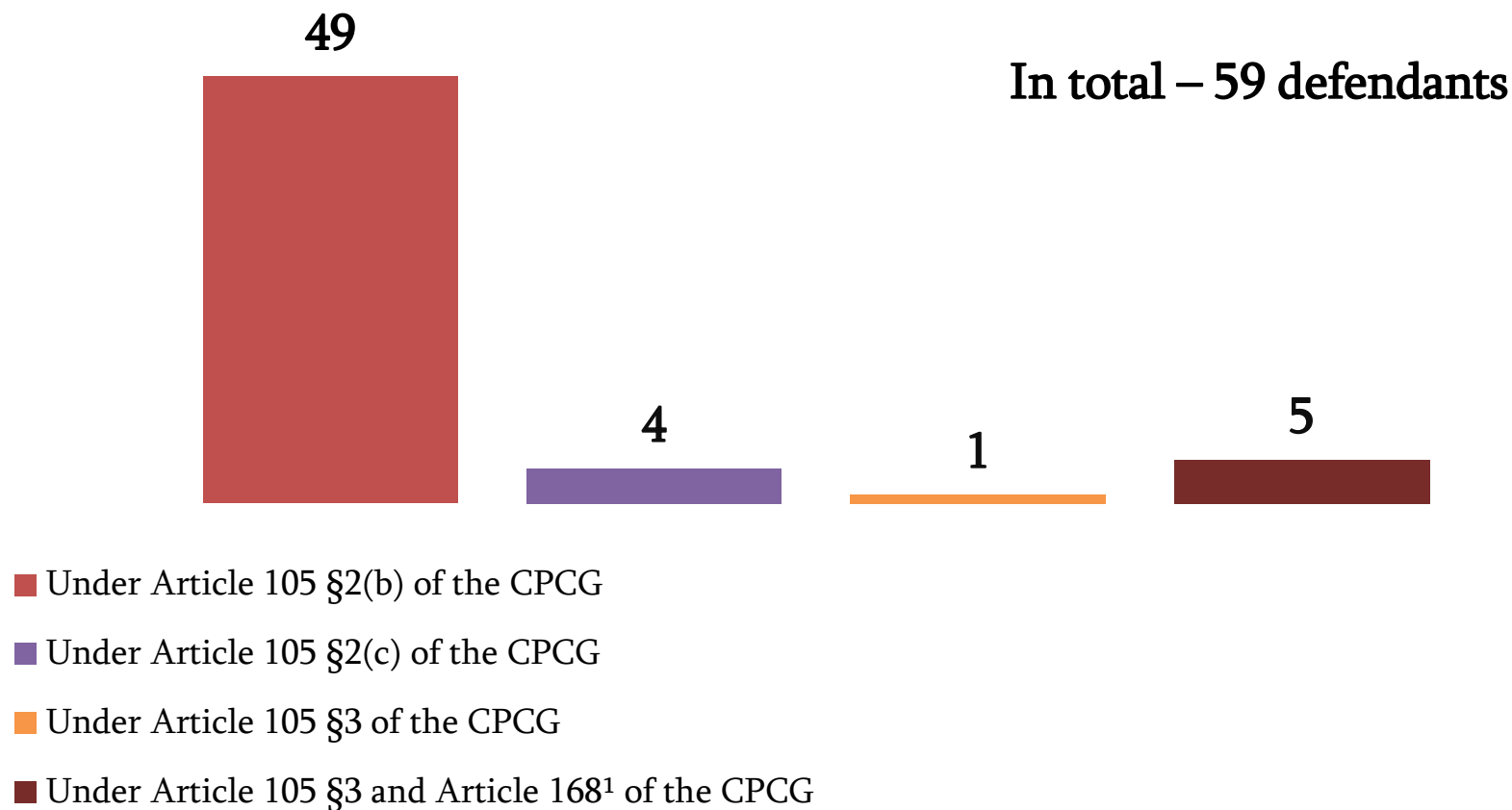

# TERMINATION OF PROSECUTION ON CRIMES AGAINST THE OLDER PERSONS



# TRENDS

- In 2023, for crimes committed against the older persons prosecution was launched against a total of **560** individuals, and **648** individuals were identified as victims.
- By territorial distribution, the highest rates of prosecution and victim identification are recorded in **Tbilisi, Western Georgia, and Shida Kartli**;
- **91%** of defendants prosecuted for crimes against the older persons are men, and **9%** are women.
- **59,8%** of victims in crimes against the older persons are women, and **40,2%** are men.
- **84,1%** of victims in crimes against the older persons are from 65 to 80 years old, **11,3%** are from 80 to 85 years old, and **4,6%** are above 85 years old.
- **72,8%** of defendants committed crimes against their elderly family members.



# TRENDS

- **37,5%** of defendants prosecuted for sexual violence against the older persons committed crimes against their elderly neighbors.
- **37,5%** of defendants prosecuted for crimes against life against the older persons committed those crimes against their elderly family members.
- An intolerance motive has been identified with regard to **29** defendants prosecuted for crimes against the older persons. Out of these defendants, **86,2%** had a gender-based intolerance motive, **10,3%** had an age-based intolerance motive, and **3,5%** had a disability-based intolerance motive.
- **37%** of defendants prosecuted for crimes against the older persons are addicted to alcohol, drugs, and/or gambling;
- On crimes against the older persons, prosecution was terminated with regard to **10,5%** of defendants.
- Out of the **59** defendants against whom prosecution was terminated, in **83%** of cases, the defendant's insanity was ground for termination.
